

Privacy Statement

Personal data that we process

Wouter Nolet Stichting processes your personal data because you use our services and / or because you provide this data to us yourself.

Below you will find an overview of the personal data that we process:

- First and last name
- E-mail address

In the case of a donation, we also process the following data:

- Address data
- Anonymous transaction data for payment processing

Declaration

Our website and / or service do not intend to collect data about website visitors under the age of 16, unless they have permission from parents or guardian. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore advise parents to be involved in the online activities of their children, to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. For what purpose and on what basis do we process personal data?

Wouter Nolet Stichting processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Sending our digital newsletter and any other announcements
- Being able to e-mail you if this is necessary to be able to perform our services

Automated decision making

Wouter Nolet Stichting does not take decisions based on automated processing of cases that may have (significant) consequences for individuals. These are decisions that are made by computer programs or systems, without interference of a human being (for example, an employee of Wouter Nolet Stichting).

How long do we keep personal data?

Wouter Nolet Stichting does not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to realize the purposes for which your data are collected. We use the following retention periods for the following (categories) of personal data:

- Personal details > 5 years
- Address > 5 years
- And so on > 5 years

We assume that you want to be kept informed about the activities of Wouter Nolet Stichting for a longer period of time. Once every five years we will ask you if your information is still correct and if you still want to have your information included.

Sharing of personal data with third parties

Wouter Nolet Stichting does not sell your data to third parties and will only provide this if this is necessary for the implementation of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. With organizations that process your data in our order, we make processor agreements to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Wouter Nolet Stichting remains responsible for these processes.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Wouter Nolet Stichting only uses technical and functional cookies and analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remember your preferred settings. We can also use this to optimize our website. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information that was previously saved via the settings of your browser.

Payments

For the processing of payments, the Wouter Nolet Stichting uses the services of Paytium and Mollie in combination with iDeal.

Paytium does not have access to the personal and address details that you enter when placing an order on this website. Paytium only establishes the connection between the website www.wnsf.nl, Mollie and iDEAL. In the Paytium privacy statement you can read how Paytium handles privacy-sensitive information.

Mollie keeps track of the payment status for each transaction and updates it, so that Wouter Nolet Stichting knows when the donation has arrived. In Mollie's privacy statement you can read how Mollie handles privacy-sensitive information.

With regard to making a payment via iDEAL, you are responsible for checking whether you use a secure connection with your payment and you will find the iDEAL privacy statement on the iDEAL website.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by our organization and you have the right to data transferability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that we hold about you in a computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you.

If you want to make use of your right to object and / or data transferability or if you have other questions / comments about data processing, please send a specified request to our e-mail address: info@wnsf.nl.

To ensure that the request for inspection has been made by you, we request that you send a copy of your proof of identity with the request. Make in this copy your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number (BSN) black. This is to protect your privacy. Wouter Nolet Stichting will respond to your request as quickly as possible, but in any case within four weeks.
